Program Overview

The Odyssey Program is an in person **5-week paid summer leadership internship** open to undergraduates from all fields of study. The principles and practices taught are applicable to every pathway, whether personal, academic, or professional.

Participants will learn and apply the management philosophies of **Dr. W. Edwards Deming** (Theory of Profound Knowledge) and **Dr. Eliyahu Goldratt** (Theory of Constraints), gaining tools to understand systems, resolve conflicts, measure performance, and drive continuous improvement. Students gain direct exposure to Comstock's work in **biofuels (Bioleum, Wisconsin)**, **solar panel recycling**, and **sustainable mining (Nevada)**, blending classroom-style learning with real-world, project-based experience.
